

# **Azalea Dog Training Club COVID-19 Policy for Classes**

In the interest of protecting the health and safety of all persons coming to ADTC to take classes or to train, ADTC has set the following guidelines and precautions for the benefit of all that come to our club. Our policy is to emphasize safety of our members, instructors, and students.

## **General Practices and Guidelines**

1. If you have been outside of the country in the past 30 days, please do not come to the building.
2. All persons are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines that apply to the area, including guidelines set forth by the City of Wilmington and County of New Hanover.
3. If you have any symptoms, including, but not limited to, fever, cough, sneezing, headache, please do NOT come to the building. If you show symptoms and come to the building, you will be asked to leave.
4. Your temperature will be taken when you walk into the building. If your temperature is above 99.8 degrees, you will be asked to leave.
5. You MUST wear a mask at all times.
6. You must sign a waiver.
7. You will be required to sign an acknowledgment that you are not currently experiencing any symptoms, that you have not been knowingly exposed to the virus, that you have not been outside of the country in the past 30 days, and that nobody in your household is experiencing symptoms, or has tested positive for COVID-19 every time you come to class.
8. No observers are allowed. No persons other than the (one) person training the dog are allowed in the building. If the person training the dog is a minor, one parent or guardian may be admitted at the discretion of the instructor, provided they stay out of the way of the students in class and stay in the area designated by the instructor.
9. Students will not be allowed to enter the building until 5 minutes before your scheduled class time.
10. If the number of COVID cases spikes or changes in an unfavorable way, ADTC reserves the right to cancel/postpone classes until the Board of Directors feels it is safe to open back up. If we postpone classes after classes have begun, we will make every effort to refund the prorated class fee to the student.

## **All Classes:**

1. Class maximum of 6 students, 1 instructor and 1 assistant.
2. Keep a distance of 6 feet from each other at ALL TIMES.
3. Chairs will be set up along the wall for teams to sit while other teams are working.
4. Use disposable gloves to set equipment and bars, and dispose after each use.
5. If you crate your dog, it will be your responsibility to sanitize and clean the crate after you use it.

### **Additional Guidelines for Agility Classes:**

1. Enter through right gate and exit through left gate when running a course.
2. Only 1 student on the floor at a time when running.
3. When walking the course, everyone must wear a mask and maintain social distance.
4. You must wear a mask when running the course.

### **Between Classes:**

1. After each class, all surfaces and equipment will be sanitized.
2. There will be a minimum of 30 minutes between each class to allow for sanitizing and cleaning and setting up for the next class.
